

We helped facilitate the launch of the Consulates Hajj advice at the APPG meeting before Ramadan and arranged meetings with Saudia and British Airways to distribute flyers to pilgrims at check in. We spent a day during Hajj visiting the British Hajj camps, engaging with British pilgrims and groups in raising awareness should they require any assistance.

We would like to thank Al-Hijaz Tours and Travels Ltd and Penny Appeal and supporting partners for supporting our Hajj Roadshows and to the speakers and trainers who delivered the sessions. We will continue our work in educating pilgrims so that they get the best possible experience from Hajj & Umrah.

CBHUK was invited as community partner for the Hajj research by Prof. Seán Mcloughlin at the University of Leeds. Following a series of community consultations, the first Independent Report on the UK Hajj sector was launched at our APPG meeting ahead of Hajj 2019.

I hope this report acts as a reference tool for anyone wanting to engage with the UK Hajj & Umrah sector in identifying key stakeholders and recommendations which helps in establishing a consensus and unity. Ahead of Hajj, CBHUK and Licensed Hajj Organisers teamed up to deliver a Hajj Awareness Campaign the first step towards collaboration.

During Hajj we were on the ground to provide support to British pilgrims and tour operators. During Hajj, I had the pleasure of attending the 44th Grand Hajj Symposium organised by the Ministry of Hajj & Umrah held at the Makkah Hilton Convention. I was impressed in the way in which it sought to highlight the lessons from Hajj in Peace, Co-existence & Tolerance - Something every Hajji can take back to his/her country.

I saw first hand the implementation of the Smart Hajj Tech being trialled for 2019 and soon to be introduced the new Maqam online booking system for the new Umrah season which will bring about a B2C model in booking a pilgrimage package. We commend the efforts of the Kingdom in developing and delivering services for pilgrims.

Two volunteers were deployed from CBHUK to Hajj 2019 to support British pilgrims inclduing myself and we are grateful to Dome Tours International for hosting us and everyone who supported us once we were out there. Through our partnership with LHO and through the use of technology we kept tour groups updated and provided live information as and when it was required.

We would like to thank Dr Imran Zia (Group Doctor for Al Hidaayah Travel) for once again acting as our Doctor on Call. His experience and services were invaluable in providing support for pilgrims. For other medical assistance pilgrims were sign posted to local Saudi Pharmacies, Health Centres, Clinics and to volunteer doctors from the BHD. We have documented the key highlights of our work in this souvenir brochure to give you a snapshot of the last season.

We will continue to build partnerships in the UK and Saudi Arabia that will ultimately benefit British pilgrims.

"I would like to take this opportunity to thank Rashid Mogradia, CEO of the Council of British Hajjis, and all the other organisations and tour operators for their efforts to support British pilgrims," the envoy said.

Qureshi said: "I would like to thank Seif Usher for hosting the cross-party group in Jeddah. It is important that we understand the issues facing British pilgrims on the ground when they are on Hajj and Umrah, and work closely with the British consulate and the Ministry of Hajj and Umrah to address any issues so that people have a positive (pilgrimage) experience."

Hussain highlighted the challenges, such as travel fraud, facing the UK Hajj and Umrah industry. He welcomed advances in technology to help pilgrims in line with the Kingdom's Vision 2030 reforms.

Rashid Mogradia, CEO of the Council of British Hajjis, highlighted the work of the charity and the parliamentary group in educating pilgrims when booking a pilgrimage package.

Recent annual Hajj awards held at the Intercontinental Park Lane London had brought a positive outlook to the Hajj and Umrah sector, he said. Al-Sharif accepted the award for the Ministry's eHajj system. The British consulate in Jeddah collected the best UK public sector award for services to British pilgrims.

First Independent Report on Hajj



In 2019, supported by funding from the LSSI/ ESRC Impact Acceleration Account, Prof. Seán McLouglin from the University of Leeds launched the first independent report – Mapping the UK's Hajj Sector: Moving towards communication and consensus (2019) – on the UK Hajj Sector at British Parliament during a meeting of the All-Party Parliamentary Group (APPG) on Hajj and Umrah.

In collaboration with the Council of British Hajjis (CBHUK), which serves as the Secretariat for the APPG, during March 2019 the project team convened three regional stakeholder consultation events with Muslim organisations, licensed Hajj organisers and UK governance authorities.

The report also draws upon more than 30 hours of in-depth interviews conducted with key stakeholders, including UK tour operators and guides, pilgrim welfare organisations, government officials, trading standards officers, as well as the Civil Aviation Authority, since 2011.









The late Lord Adam Patel

(7 June 1940 - 29 May 2019)

Obituary by Rashid Mogradia Founder & CEO, CBHUK

Saddened by the passing away of my dear friend and mentor Lord Adam Patel of Blackburn earlier today during the blessed month of Ramadan 1440H.

A formidable businessman and a community champion who was humble, loving and caring and above all a selfless individual who put others first.

Many in his inner circle referred to him as LP, for me he was Adam Mama (Uncle in Gujrati) and he liked that, it was more fitting of my relationship with him of not just a politician but that of a family member.

I first saw him action when he rallied for Labour in my hometown of Bolton at the 2001 General Election. It wasn't until 2005 I actually met him in person during my first Hajj in Mina when I visited him in the British Hajj Delegation camp. I was fascinated with the support our Government was providing and impressed how someone like Adam Mama (an elder from our British Muslim Indian Gujrati Community) was leading a delegation of volunteer doctors and consular officials.

In late 2006 I met him again at an MCB Health at Hajj event in London and we struck up a conversation of relaying the technical health advice into the public domain. Within a few weeks Council of British Hajjis was born and we delivered our first Health at Hajj educational event with his support and that of our local Imam Rashid Ali, Dr Mo Jiva, local councillors and the then local MP Dr Brian Iddon.

For over a decade he was always there for me to offer guidance and steer and was passionate in serving British pilgrims. Every time I visited him in London either in Parliament or at his home he would make sure I had eaten or at least had a cup of desi chai before I left, such was his and his family's hospitality.

Sadly he fell ill in 2016 and I remember vividly visiting him in hospital, unable to converse he greeted me with his signature smile as he had done on many occasions before. He was truly a gentleman who made you feel as though you were his best friend.

He leaves behind a lovely family and a legacy of projects (not least with CBHUK) which will continue to act as a continuous reward (Sadqa Jaaria) for him, God willing.

I pray Allah Almighty blesses his soul, elevates his status and grants him Jannatul Firdaus, Ameen.



We have been honoured this year with a great line up of Judges who joined our panel to bring their expertise and critique to the Judging process and to whom we thank for their time and support.



He co-founded the All-Party Parliamentary Group on Hajj & Umrah and was listed as a 'Trailblazer' in the 2018 Muslim Power 100 List.






